## **Congress Takes Action to Pass Three Coronavirus Bills**

During the month of March,
neck surgeons grappling with impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic on their patients and their practices. Congress
passed, and President Trump signed into law, three separate pieces of legislation to address the COVID-19
pandemic. On Marchc6a26906(be)f13020exxxvirus legislative package, The Coronavirus Preparedness and
Response Supplemental Appropriations Act 2020, was enacted into law. This legislation provided \$8.3 billion
in emergency funding for federal agencies to immediately respond to the outbreak. Then, on March 18, 2020,
the President signed, ies First Coronavirus Response Act. which focused on paid sick leave, tax
credits, free COVID-19 testing, as well as expanding food assistance programs, increasing Medicaid funding,
and unemployment assistance. Lastly, on March 27, 2020, President Trump signed
Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act, into law. The CARES Act provides emergency relief to
individuals and businesses during the COVID-19 crisis. The Act includes \$2.2 trillion in aid for smalw12 0 612 7E Tm0
