xCAST: Two topical podcasts with leading experts.

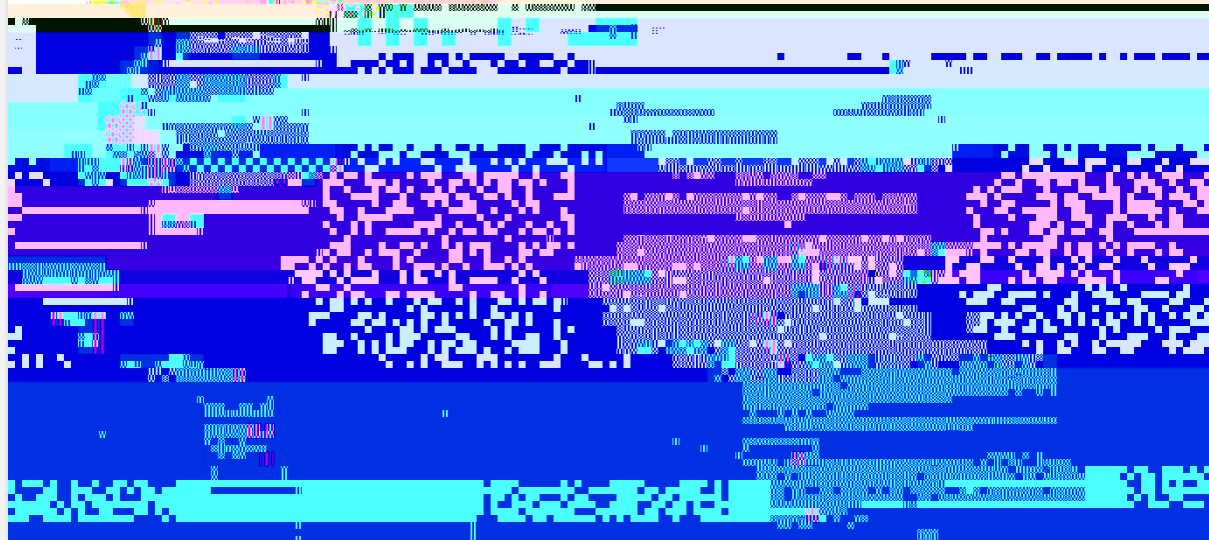
